

The North West Company Brings Life-Saving Technology and CPR Training to Stores

For Immediate Release – At The North West Company’s annual Wintering Partners Conference, held in Winnipeg, Manitoba from February 7 to February 11, 2012, 222 store managers and other staff from the company’s locations in Canada, Alaska, the Caribbean and South Pacific, received extensive cardiopulmonary resuscitation or CPR and automated external defibrillator or AED training.

CPR is an emergency procedure which is performed in an effort to manually preserve intact brain function until further measures are taken to restore spontaneous blood circulation and breathing in a person in cardiac arrest.

An AED is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses the potentially life threatening cardiac arrhythmias in a patient and is able to treat them through defibrillation, the application of electrical therapy which stops the arrhythmia, allowing the heart to reestablish an effective rhythm.

In addition to the training, done by Rescue 7, each of The North West Company stores, support offices and warehouses will be equipped with a HeartSine AED, which is an easy-to-use portable device ideally suited for remote communities where anyone can be called on as a first-responder.

“The positive response from our employees to the time to take CPR and AED training on February 9th and then to have the ability to provide our customers and the community with this valuable and potentially life-saving service was overwhelming,” says Edward Kennedy, President and CEO, The North West Company. “In rural and more isolated communities this capability is especially important.”
